# CALL COMPANION

## Calling all Companions!

Our Call Companions service provides a friendly weekly phone call to lonely isolated people in our local community.

We aim to help reduce loneliness and isolation in vulnerable people in our community, and keep our clients connected to our services and volunteers.

## What will I do?

As a Call Companion volunteer, you will speak to one or more lonely and isolated people over the telephone weekly. Your role is to listen, be supportive and provide a friendly listening ear to help reduce the loneliness of the clients you support.

Your role will be to:

- Provide support over the telephone to a vulnerable, lonely and/or isolated client.
- Speak to your clients once or twice a week.
- Build up a rapport and a trusted telephone friendship
- Provide a friendly listening ear.
- Maintain confidentiality.

## Where will I be?

You will generally make calls from your own home and at a time to suit both you and your Call Companions client.

## How much time is needed of me?

The time spent on your Call Companions call is flexible and on average our Call Companion volunteers spend between one and three hours per week on their calls.

## What we can offer you

All volunteers will be provided with welcome and induction training covering confidentiality, boundaries, expectations and safeguarding. Additional training is available, particularly on handling telephone calls.

Ongoing support from the Call Companions Coordinator is provided.

Paul set up the Call Companions scheme 6 years ago with just 5 clients. Now the call companions scheme makes over 140 calls per week to lonely and isolated people in Glossopdale.
