Do not share personal information like your address, email address or phone number.

Only talk to real life friends or family online. Don't befriend people you don't know.

Use privacy setting where they exist to keep information private.

Be a good online friend and don't say mean things.

Don't post pictures or videos of yourself online without checking with an adult.

Never give out passwords.

Remember that not everyone online is who they say they are.

If you see something that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or worried, tell a trusted adult immediately.

Respect other people's views. Even if you don't agree, be polite.
